



## ROTARY CLUB OF WEST SEATTLE GAMBRIELL SCHOLARSHIP

**DEADLINE: April 1, 2021**

### **DESCRIPTION:**

The Vern Gambriell Scholarship is an annual award totaling about \$6,000 granted to one or more students in order to make it possible for students to pursue a post-secondary educational program at an accredited institution.

The specific desire of this West Seattle donor (Vern Gambriell) is that assistance is provided to **students who would not otherwise be able to attend college and that preference will be given to residents of West Seattle.** Therefore, this scholarship is awarded based on financial need.

Each award is for one year and is annually renewable. Recipient(s) must re-apply for consideration each year before the stated deadlines.

### **QUALIFICATIONS:**

1. Applicant must be seeking admission to or enrolled in an accredited post-secondary educational program.
2. Applicant must be in financial need. Documentation must be provided in request.
3. Applicant would not otherwise be able to attend college without this scholarship.

### **HOW TO APPLY:**

1. Fill out Part 1 of the application completely. Do not leave any areas blank. Incomplete applications will not be considered.
2. Complete part 2 of the application and sign.
3. Write an essay describing your educational and career goals; include what motivates you, your personal experiences to this point and how they have influenced you, and what you hope to achieve in your personal and professional life after completing your chosen educational goals: The essay must be typed, double-spaced and a maximum of 2 pages. Include your name, address, phone number, email address in the heading. Sign your essay.
4. Mail or email the completed application before the April 1<sup>st</sup> deadline. Late applications will not be considered.
